INTRODUCTION and CONTEXT

The Government of Cabo Verde, is in the process of initiating the implementation of the World Bank funded *DIGITAL CABO VERDE PROJECT*, which intends to support Government of Cabo Verde in the implementation of key priority initiatives of the national ICT Policy Implementation and eGovernment Strategies as well as to continue supporting the strengthening of the national Telecommunication sector. The activities of the project are focused on the following three major areas, each consisting of a number of sub-projects and covering a number of public services and institutions:

- Technical Assistance to National Information and Communication Technology (ICT)
 Institutions
- Connectivity Infrastructures and Services
- eGovernment Platforms and Applications

The National Directorate for Telecommunications and Digital Economy at Ministry of Finance ("MF DGTED Directorate") is searching for a highly qualified Digital Economy professional for the position as Policy Adviser for the National Directorate for Telecommunications and Digital Economy ("Adviser"), working within the UGPE and to the Secretary of State for Innovation and Technical Training at Government of Cabo Verde, the Advisor will be positioned and will directly report to the MF DGTED Directorate. The Adviser will play a fundamental role in supporting the implementation of the Digital Cabo Verde Project component 1 and 2 from the technical perspective in accordance with the Government and World Bank procedures and regulations.

A particular attention will be paid to the "iniciativa de Praia" initiative which was carried out and proposed by the Republic of Cape Verde during the course of the 15th Meeting of the ECOWAS Ministers in charge of telecommunications/ICT held in Praia in October 2017. This initiative which falls within the scope of the ECOWAS Broadband Backbone, propose the laying of the "Amílcar Cabral Submarine Cable" which would connect Cabo Verde, Guinea-Bissau, with Liberia, Guinea Conakry, Sierra Leone, Gambia and Senegal. About \$70 million is how much the integration of the Amílcar Cabral fiber optic cable as part of the creation of a hub connectivity in Cabo Verde and the ECOWAS project of the single digital market through multiple submarine cables international.

OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSIGNMENT

The general objectives of the Assignment are:

- To provide advice and support on overall Programme management, advance capacity building and the implementation of activities for the Digital Cabo Verde Project related to the MF DGTED
- To ensure the effective transfer and adaptability of the international expertise, lessons and best practices to the production of quality program outputs for the MF DGTED
- To enhance the cooperation with national institutions and stakeholders for effective implementation and synergies.

More particularly, the Amilcar Cabral project related objectives of the consultant will be to provide daily technical assistance to cover all the necessary steps for the selection of the supplier.

Globally this technical assistance is aiming at:

- delivering detailed analysis of the needs, the technical architecture proposed, and costs evaluation for the optical fiber links project;
- delivering the technical specification for the call to tender in order to build the submarine systems;
- assisting GOCV for the recruitment and selection of a supplier.

SCOPE OF WORK AND DELIVERABLES OF ADVISOR

The more specific duties and responsibilities include ensuring the effective and flexible technical focal point of the project components of the Digital Cabo Verde projects for which the MF DGTED is responsive. This will be done in full collaboration the General Directorate of DGTED, and Ministry of Finance:

The Advisor will provide the following detailed services:

- Provided policy and technical advice of high quality and relevance.
- Provided high quality advice on capacity building needs and plans.
- Provided high quality inputs into project work plans and reports.
- Provided high quality Terms of Reference and advice on recruitment of appropriate consultants.
- Provided program management advice (planning, monitoring and evaluation) of high quality and relevance.
- Sound contribution to the development and operation of government on Digital Cabo
 Verde Project.
- Effective and active networking and good team work between the UGPE, Secretary of State for Innovation and Technical Training at Government of Cabo Verde, Ministry of Education.

As far as the Amilcar Cabral Project is concerned, the Advisor shall work with and advise GOCV at all stages including the initial technical assessment and the selection of the Supplier.

The Advisor will support GOCV during the following steps.

Pre-study of the links specification

The Advisor will make a preliminary study covering the following aspects:

- Evaluation of needs and Project's links dimensioning and main design characteristics;
- Location of landing points and cable route preliminary design. Landing points should be recommended by the Advisor based on economic, environmental, commercial, technical and potential onward national connectivity. The adaptation of existing landing stations must be studied in the same way as the construction of new ones.

Output: Pre-Study Final Report

Drafting of technical specifications

Based on the pre-study report, the Advisor shall draft the detailed System Technical Specifications for the tender. These specifications will cover at least the following aspects:

- System engineering
- Cable route survey
- Provision and installation of new landing stations and/or adaptation of existing ones
- Submarine cable types
- Terminal equipment
- Network Management System
- Land cable route construction and land cable installation
- Marine installation
- Factory acceptance
- Quality control
- System acceptance.

These specifications will be included in a request for tenders for the selection of a supplier for the provision of the cable systems.

Output: Technical Specification, technical evaluation criteria.

Assistance in supplier selection

Answers Phase

The Advisor shall assist GOCV in order to submit answers to Contractors technical questions concerning the tender.

The Advisor will review and clarify the tender clarification questions against the agreed set of criteria (to be developed by the Bidder in coordination with GOCV)

Evaluation Phase

The advisor will issue a request for BAFO (Best And Final Offer) from the tenderers

The advisor will draft an evaluation report, based on submitted BAFOs, resulting in a ranking of the Contractors in order of merit.

Output: an agreed set of evaluation guidelines and an evaluation report with detailed recommendations for the GOCV to proceed.

Clarification / Negotiation Phase

The Advisor shall provide technical assistance on a further detailed evaluation to obtain additional clarification on technical proposals.

Final Negotiations

The Advisor shall, together with GOCV, hold final negotiations with the chosen Supplier in order to agree the and technical aspects of the final contract.

In addition, the Advisor will work closely with the established with Project Management Unit (UGPE) and more particularly with the Project Manager of the Digital Cabo Verde Project and the Coordinator of the UGPE. Where relevant, the Advisor will work with international/national consultants and other relevant stakeholders to carry out her/his job. In addition to MF DGTED Directorate, the Advisor will also report to the World Bank and liaise closely with the task Team Leader throughout the program implementation period. The Advisor
